The competitions are strictly reserved to ITSF licenses.

Players have to register **1 week at the latest before the event.**

All players will be able to check their registration on the ITSF website : www.tablesoccer.org.

When sending their online registration, federations authorize the release of photograph, video or both, taken of their players during the event, to the TFBÖ and ITSF.

Registration deadline is:

5th July 2023 INCLUDED

No registration will be taken into account after this date and whiteout payment.

LICENSES

Players must have a players license issued by their own federation to compete in ITSF events - they can have one only. Please contact your federation for details.

Registration and payment must be done by your federation or by your club through FAST software only.

Package includes 4 competitions :

- Singles Event (Open or Women or Junior or Senior)
- Doubles Event (Open or Women or Junior or Senior)
- Classic Doubles
- Mixed Doubles

Top 3 singles and doubles must attend the ceremony for photos.

Women, Junior and Senior must choose to play in their category or open events (same rule for Classic events). If there are less than 5 teams in any category they will play every team against every team and be allowed to additionally play in the adult/open category with the same partner. However, if a Junior/Women/Senior team has chosen to play the OD category, they will not be allowed to play in the Junior/Women/ Senior category. In that case with 5 teams or less, there will be no qualification for WS, WD, JS, JD, SS, SD. Format = SKO 3/5.

Note : Junior Singles and Doubles are played on Saturday : – the Schedule and number of Qualification rounds depends on the number of players. Additionally, all male U19 Juniors are allowed to play Open Singles and all female U19 Juniors are allowed to play Women Singles on Friday ! Juniors are not allowed to play Open Doubles AND Junior Singles and Doubles. Juniors can't play Junior Classic/Junior Team Cup AND Open Team Cup. **U16 Kids are not allowed to take part in women or men categories. This includes also mixed, classic and dyp categories of women and men.**

REFEREE & DRESS CODE

The tournament fee includes 5€ for the Referee fees. Referee receive payment based on their level and number of matches officiated. This fee does not guarantee a referee for all matches. There is no referring during qualification rounds. In elimination, if no referee after 10 minutes, the match must start. All Referees must wear ITSF referee shirt displaying their referee level.

Sport Dress is compulsory for ALL players during the competition including ceremonies. Please refer to ITSF Dress Code [HERE](#) for details.

COMPETITIONS FORMATS

SWISS SYSTEM FORMAT

All the qualification competitions will be played under the SWISS SYSTEM FORMAT.

QUALIFICATION

Open Singles and Doubles competitions: the title holder and 13 Men will be seeded according to ITSF Ranking.

Women Singles and Doubles competitions: the title holder and 5 Women will be seeded according to ITSF Ranking.

Senior Singles and Doubles competitions: the title holder and 5 Seniors will be seeded according to ITSF Ranking.

Seeded players/teams don't play qualifications. Seeded players can revoke their seeded place till 6 pm of the day before the competition.

Junior Singles and Doubles competitions : number of qualification matches will depend on the number of registered players.

The winner shall announce just his name (not the score).

ELIMINATION

100% players will be qualified in the 2 divisions: division A (Pro) and division B (Semi Pro).

Groups ranking will be gathered and will determine the final ITSF ranking.

DELAYS: If 9 min after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams lose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12 mins. Both teams will be eliminated after 15 min have passed since the match had been called and no game has started.

CATEGORIES

- **MEN** – Players born in 2007 and before
- **WOMEN** – Players born in 2007 and before
- **SENIOR** – Players born in 1972 and before
- **JUNIORS** – Players born in 2005 and after

CLASSIC FORMAT

ITSF Rules of play with the following exceptions:

- Player figures are not allowed to rotate 360 degrees or more when advancing the ball.
- 10 second time of possession for all rods. Goalie rods are considered one rod.
- The ball is served and put back into play at the goalie area unless otherwise specified by rule.

RULES

- Each player plays in one element
- The 4 players in D1, S1 and S2 are different players
- Each team gets 2 timeouts per match

The match is a relay :

- Element 1 (Single 1) plays until one of the 2 formations has 10 points
- Element 2 (Single 2) plays until one of the 2 formations has 20 points
- Element 3 (Double 1) plays until one of the 2 formations has 30 points

Substitutions:

- The team captain may make one substitution per match, which costs one timeout
- S1 can be substituted once one formation has reached 5 points
- S2 can be substituted once one formation has reached 15 points
- One or both players from D1 can be substituted once one formation has reached 25 points
